



Fishing Trip Checklist

- Valid California fishing license with a salmon & steelhead punch card.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather. Layer whenever possible and remember you can always take clothes off.
- Headwear of some type beanie, baseball hat, etc...
- Sunglasses, if you would like to be able to see when the sun is shining on the water. They will also protect your eyes in case your partner does not cast very well. 😊
- Sunscreen, even if it's not sunny you will still burn.
- Rain gear, even if there's no rain in the forecast.
- Waders if you would like... Fly fishermen should absolutely bring waders.
- Lunch, snacks and refreshments (water, soda, etc...) so you don't become dehydrated.
- Camera with freshly charged batteries.
- Cold medicines, just in case you're under the weather and came to fish. 😊
- A sense of humor, if you're new to fishing and even if you're not. 😊
